Day wise planner for the same has been attached below:

Day & Date	Name of the Activity	Details
Day 1 17.04.23	Listen and Draw	Students will be creating a scene based on the instructions given by the teacher. <b>Material Required</b> - White A4 size sheet, basic stationery, <u>colours</u> .
Day 2 18.04.23	Extempore	The student will be given 2 minutes prior to the speech to <b>think over the topic</b> . Each participant will be given 1 minute to <b>speak extempore on a topic picked</b> up by him or her.  Like: Books, Family, What I want to be, Safety Habits, Healthy Eating Habits, Cleanliness, <u>Zero Waste</u> etc.
Day 3 19.04.23	Write and Share	Students will be given a one liner- I love English because..... They will <b>write their reason</b> and will <b>share their views</b> in the class. <b>Material required</b> - half A4 size sheet.

Day 4 20.04.23	Riddle Fun -	Read the riddle and write its answer. A worksheet having riddles will be provided to the students, which will develop their comprehension and problem-solving skill. The answers of the riddles will also help in enhancing their vocabulary.
Day 5 21.04.23	Poem Recitation (Thank the Mother Earth)	Students must come prepared to <b>present any poem</b> of their choice to celebrate the World Earth Day.  Choose a poem that allows us to <b>praise and acknowledge nature and our mother Earth.</b>
24 <sup>th</sup> April 2023	Reading (DEAR Activity)	The students will bring an age-appropriate book of their choice and <b>DROP EVERYTHING AND READ.</b>
