Promotion Policy of Class V-VIII

Successful and unsuccessful people do not vary greatly in their ability, they vary in their desire to achieve their potential.

With reference to the guidelines received from the Directorate of Education with regard to the promotion for classes V & VIII, following are the directives that shall be implemented in the academic session 2024 – 25.

- "No Detention" policy has been withdrawn for classes V and VIII. There shall be a regular
- examination in the fifth class and in the eight class at the end of every academic year. In order to be declared 'Pass' at the end of the session for promotion to the next class, a student must secure
- minimum 33 % marks in each subject. Re-Examination will be conducted for the students who fail in a subject/ subjects. In case a student of class V & VIII does not secure 33% in that
- subject/s in Re-Examination or doesn't appear in it, he/she will be placed in the category of
- "Essential Repeat" (ER). Such a student will be held back in the same class during the next session.

We anticipate that all our students will appear in the assessments with seriousness and thorough study, aiming to excel and not just pass in a particular test/ exam. Our constant endeavour shall be to inspire our young students to be achievers and not just dreamers.
