Circular for Class XI Admission (Session 2026-27)

Dear Parent,

Namaskar!

As we prepare for the new academic session of Class XI, scheduled to commence on 13 April 2026, we are pleased to announce the initiation of the admission process for session 2026-2027, exclusively for our students of Class X (Session 2025-26).

Since the academic session will commence prior to the declaration of the CBSE Board results, admissions to Class XI will be based on the better subject-wise performance in the Pre-Board 1 and Pre-Board 2 examinations.

Enclosed with this circular is the stream-wise eligibility list prepared on the basis of the better subject-wise performance in Pre-Board 1 and Pre-Board 2 examinations. Parents are requested to review the list carefully while selecting the stream and subject combination for their ward during the admission process.

1. Provisional Cut-off Percentages (Based on Pre-Board Exams)

Science (Medical): AGG \geq 65% and SCI \geq 65%

Science (Non-Medical): AGG \geq 65%, SCI \geq 65%, and MATHS \geq 65%

Commerce (with Maths): AGG \geq 55% and MATHS \geq 55%

Commerce (without Maths): AGG \geq 50%

Humanities: Open to all students

Kindly note that the above cut-offs are provisional and may be revised after the declaration of the CBSE Board results.

2. Improvement Examination Opportunity

Students who are unable to secure their desired stream or subject due to low scores in the Pre-Board examinations are being provided with one additional opportunity to improve their subject-wise performance through Improvement Exams.

Students who already meet the eligibility criteria for their preferred stream or subjects do not need to appear for these exams.

A student may choose to appear in one or more improvement examinations, depending on the subjects they wish to improve.

4. Important: Admission Deadline

The admission process will commence from 13th March 2026. To secure your ward's seat, the admission fee must be deposited on or before 2nd April 2026.

Failure to complete the admission formalities within the stipulated deadline may result in forfeiture of the seat, and the school reserves the right to deny admission thereafter.

5. Online Admission Procedure

8. Revision of Cut-Off After Board Results

After the declaration of the CBSE Board results, the school reserves the right to review and revise the stream eligibility cut-offs, if required.

Any request for upgradation of stream or subject will be considered on the basis of the revised cut-off criteria and subject to availability of seats in the respective stream and subject combination at that time.

Students who have already secured admission will not be downgraded to another stream or subject on the basis of the revised cut-off criteria.

9. Scholarship Criteria (Based on CBSE Board Results)

Aggregate %	Scholarship on Tuition Fee
98% and above	100% on Tuition Fee
95% – 97.99%	60% on Tuition Fee
92.5% – 94.99%	35% on Tuition Fee
90% – 92.49%	20% on Tuition Fee

- The scholarship amount will be adjusted in the tuition fee for the academic session (2026-27) after verification of the Board result.
- Marks secured in the additional subject AI will not be considered for scholarship calculation.
- Only students who complete the admission formalities by 3 April 2026 will be eligible for the scholarship.
