| Day   | Skill                         | Activity   |

| Day 1 | Listening- Let's Be All Ears! | An audio story will be played for students. Students will identify elements of the story: beginning, middle and end and create a story map.  |
| Day 2 | Speaking – Protagonist Parade | A Fancy Dress show will be organized for the students of standard 3, 4 & 5. The students have to dress up as their favourite fictional or non-fictional characters. They have to speak a few lines on the character chosen by them. The students must show their creativity in the costumes they wear, and should put their best foot forward with confident dialogue delivery and confidence. |
| Day 3 | Grammar – Grammar Basketball  | All the students have to prepare questions pertaining to the language. It may include and mind-boggling tricky riddles questions based on tenses and parts of speech. Students are required to write the same on a slip and share with their respective English teachers.  |
