Revision Schedule Class XII

Dear Parent

‘Preparation is the key to success’

We anticipate that your ward is utilising his time to the optimum. The school too has prepared a comprehensive Revision schedule before the Pre-Board exam and after it as well to further strengthen the concepts of each subject and sharpen the skills. Understanding the learning difficulties of students, they have been divided into three categories viz. Category A, B and Super- Elite group

- Category A comprises of Elite and Average students
- Category B comprises of Remedial students
- Super elite students

Each group would be given special attention depending on their level of understanding and performance in the school exams.

Kindly note the Revision plan being shared below:

1. Super elite

- (i) Sample paper or worksheets will be sent daily. They will be discussed over zoom. Time: between 4 PM to 8 PM. Zoom link will be shared by the subject teacher a day in advance. Attendance will be taken for the same.
- (ii) A Mock test will be conducted in off-line mode for which checking will be done by the teacher on the same day. A feedback session will be conducted soon after.

2. Group A: Elite and Average students

- (i) Group A will be called for two days during the preparatory holidays for every subject.
- (ii) Group A test from 7:15 am to 8:45 am
- (iii) Test discussion from 8:45 am to 10:15 am

3. Group B Remedial group

- (i) Group B will be called daily during preparatory holidays.
- (ii) Daily one worksheet will be given to them.
- (iii) 7:45 AM to 8:45 AM. Discussion of the previous worksheet will be held.
- (iv) 8:45 AM to 10:00 am revision.
- (v) 10 to 10:15 am a short test will be conducted on the topic taught.

Attendance in Remedial classes is mandatory for bridging the learning gaps. Attendance will be taken by the respective subject teachers.

The school's commitment to attain excellence in education will continue after Pre-Board 1 as well. Repeated testing boosts the student's confidence and ensures their preparation for their pen-ultimate exam. Students who are inconsistent and shy away from exams will suffer from issues like anorexia nervosa which is common among students. As parents it is imperative that you encourage your ward to make maximum use of the zealous efforts being made by our teachers to ensure that each and every student performs to his potential and acs the exam. Moreover, an individual's attitude determines his altitude. Guide your ward to dream big and to work towards the realisation of the dream.

Kindly take note of the **Post Pre-Board 1 Revision Plan**

- (i) Block teaching timetable will be shared covering maximum subjects every day. Special classes will be conducted for students scoring less than the minimum desired score on: 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30th December.
- (ii) In each class 15 minutes discussion of previous sheet, 70 minutes discussion of new sheet, followed by 15 minutes test will be conducted.
- (iii) From 2 January 2024 to 5th January Physics, Accounts, Pol. Science, subjects having first exam, plan will be followed.

Revision Plan during Pre-Board 2

- (i) Answer sheet of Super Elite of Pre-board 2 will be checked, before the next Pre-board exam and will be discussed individually with super elite students after the next Pre-board.
- (ii) One Remedial and one Doubt class will be conducted online everyday between the gaps of Pre-boards by all the teachers.
- (iii) Daily a work sheet will be sent for the Remedial group students
