Introduction of Three Prestigious New Award Categories

Dear Parents,
Namaste!

At Vivekanand School, we have always believed that every child possesses unique strengths and potential that deserve to be recognised, nurtured, and celebrated. Our High Honour Awards Ceremony has, over the years, stood as a proud tradition of applauding students who distinguish themselves in academics, co-curricular pursuits, sports, discipline, leadership, values, and personal growth.

In our continuous endeavour to further strengthen this culture of motivation, excellence, and holistic development, we are delighted to announce the introduction of three prestigious new award categories in the existing framework of the High Honour Awards, effective from Session 2026–27 onwards.

1. Student of the Year Award

This distinguished title shall be conferred upon one outstanding student from each standard who emerges as the most accomplished achiever across all sections.

The award will recognise the student who secures the highest cumulative number of awards under the various categories of the High Honour Awards in that academic session, thereby reflecting not only scholastic merit but also holistic brilliance, consistency, participation, and exemplary performance across multiple domains.

Tie-Breaking Criterion

In the event of two or more students securing an equal number of awards, the honour shall be bestowed upon the student with the higher academic percentage in the final result.

This award aims to celebrate the spirit of versatility, sustained excellence, and all-round distinction, inspiring students to strive beyond boundaries and make their mark in every sphere of school life.

2. Academic Consistency Award

While the Scholar Award recognises students who secure 90% and above marks, the school also acknowledges those students who consistently maintain a good academic standard over a sustained period of time.

To encourage such learners, the Academic Consistency Award shall be presented to students who secure 85% to 89.99% marks consecutively for three academic years.

This category has been introduced to recognise students who have displayed regularity in their academic performance and have consistently remained close to the Scholar Award benchmark.

The award seeks to motivate students to continue their academic journey with dedication, perseverance, and a renewed determination to achieve even higher levels of excellence in the years ahead.

Eligibility Criteria

This award shall be conferred only upon students who secure 85% to 89.99% marks in each of the three consecutive academic years under consideration.

Accordingly:

- A student scoring below 85% in any of the three years shall not be eligible.
- A student scoring 90% or above in any of the three years shall not be eligible.
- Students receiving the Scholar Award, Merit Award or any higher academic recognition during the three-year period shall not be considered for this award.

For example:

✓ 86%, 88%, 89% – Eligible

✗ 84%, 87%, 89% – Not Eligible

✗ 88%, 90%, 89% – Not Eligible

✗ 88%, 86%, 91% – Not Eligible (Student becomes eligible for a higher academic recognition)

✗ 87%, 88%, 89% (Class XI Merit Award recipient) – Not Eligible (Student becomes eligible for a Merit Award only)

Implementation Clause

The Academic Consistency Award is being introduced with effect from Session 2026–27. For the purpose of this award, only the academic performance from Class VI onwards shall be considered. Performance in the Primary Wing shall not be taken into account.

Accordingly, during Session 2026–27, only students studying in Class VIII and above shall be eligible for consideration, as they alone would have completed the required three-year evaluation period from Class VI onwards.

Through this recognition, the school aims to reinforce the belief that consistent effort and continuous improvement are important stepping stones towards greater academic success.

3. GoSharpener Green Contributor Award

In order to encourage environmental consciousness, sustainable habits, and meaningful participation among students, the school has introduced the GoSharpener Green Contributor Award.

Under this category, the Top 3 students from each standard shall be recognised annually for their outstanding contribution and active participation in sustainability-related initiatives through the GoSharpener platform.

The selection shall be based on the overall meaningful contribution made by the student throughout the academic session and on the holistic evaluation carried out by the school committee.

The following aspects may be considered during the evaluation process:

- Meaningful Sustainable Actions
- Consistency & Participation
- Creativity & Positive Impact
- Authenticity of Efforts
- Contribution towards building environmental awareness

Important Note

- This award shall not be based solely on the number of posts uploaded or GoPoints earned.
- Greater importance shall be accorded to authenticity, meaningful contribution, consistency, and the positive impact created by the student.
- Repetitive, copied, superficial, or non-genuine submissions may not be considered for recognition.
- The decision of the school committee regarding the final selection shall be final and binding.

Together, these three new award categories have been envisioned with the objective of making our recognition system more inclusive, aspirational, and reflective of varied forms of student excellence.
