Meeting Schedule:

- Roll Numbers 26 - Last roll number: 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM

Important Points to Note:

1. You are requested to follow the given schedule according to your child's roll number and be punctual. Teachers will strictly adhere to the timings mentioned above and will not be able to meet parents outside their designated time slots.
2. It is mandatory to bring access card in the PTM.
3. Attendance at the PTM is mandatory, your child is required to accompany you for the PTM in school uniform.
4. Upon entering the classroom to meet a teacher, please write the serial number and your name on the sheet provided by the student volunteer. This will help you estimate the approximate waiting time.
5. If you are not present in the room when your turn arrives, your name will be struck off, and you will need to make a fresh entry on the same sheet and rejoin the queue upon your return.

6. The teacher seating arrangement for the PTM will be shared with you for your reference.
7. Kindly limit your discussion with any teacher to 5-7 minutes. If you require a more detailed conversation, please request an appointment to meet separately at a later date.
8. We kindly request all parents to wait in the designated waiting rooms to maintain decorum. Please spare sufficient time for the meeting and exercise patience while waiting for your turn. Maintaining a respectful and calm atmosphere is crucial for the benefit of all attending.

Please Note: If a parent doesn't arrive in their assigned time slot due to some unavoidable circumstances, their entry will still be recorded. However, preference will be given to parents whose time slot is currently active, even if they arrive after you.
