As part of our ongoing efforts to promote a culture of reading among our students, we are excited to introduce a new initiative aimed at fostering a love for reading and recognizing our students' literary accomplishments. This will be done as a new category of achievement called 'Reading Maestro' as part of the existing prestigious 'Vivekanand Ratna Award'. As the name suggests, this category is designed to celebrate our young readers who exhibit exceptional dedication and interest towards English/Hindi literature and language.

It will be structured as follows:

Reading Recommendations:

To participate in this category, students will be suggested two books related to one or two distinct genres in each quarter. These genres will be carefully selected to cater to various reading preferences and age groups.

Book-Based Quiz:

After exploring the recommended books, students will get an opportunity to participate in the multiple-choice quizzes (MCQ) for each book which will be scheduled at the end of the quarter. To ensure that our students get the best chance of preparation and reflection, the quizzes will be held one week apart for each book. These quizzes will serve as a means for students to demonstrate their understanding of the plot, characters, and themes of the books. Upon completing each book they wish to read, students will participate in the respective quizzes. Reading all or multiple books is not mandatory – this choice rests with the student.

Recognition and Appreciation:

Participating students who achieve a score of 80% or above in any of the book-based MCQ quizzes will be entitled to receive a VRA Card. This card is a token of our recognition and appreciation for their dedication to reading and their commitment to understanding the books they've read.

The addition of 'Reading Masestro' category for our students is one way we aim to nurture the passion of reading and igniting their imagination for the world at large, and celebrate all literary achievements big or small. We invite our students to participate in this initiative, explore new literary horizons, and embark on exciting reading adventures. Together, let's inspire a lifelong love for reading!
