- Number of participants-1
- Medium-English
- Dress Code-As per the story and props can be used.
- The student should narrate the story but with twist or a change in it from the original one.
- Exceeding the time limit will lead to negative marking.
- The participant must be fluent in his narration and clarity of content is required.

2. Poetic Craving

Competition- English Poem Recitation Competition

Theme- Nature

Instructions and guidelines-

- Duration-2 mins
- Number of participants-1
- The participants are required to recite a poem in English based on the theme above.
- Props can be used.

3. Puppeteers

Competition- Story telling using puppets

Instructions and guidelines-

- Duration-2-3 mins
- Number of participants-1
- Medium-English
- The participant is required to narrate a folk tale using puppets.
- Props should be used as per the theme.

4. Hindi Reading Competition

Competition-Reading Competition

Any book will be given on the spot to be read.

Instructions and guidelines-

- Dress Code-School uniform
- The participant will be given any Hindi book to be read on the spot.

- Diction & Intonation

5. Talking Titans

Competition-Extempore Comp

Theme- Health & fitness

Topic will be given on the spot.

Instructions and guidelines-

- Duration-2 mins.
- Number of participants-1
- Medium-English
- Dress Code-School uniform
- Exceeding the time limit will lead to negative marking.
- The participant will be given the topic to speak on the spot on the theme mentioned above.
- The presentation must finish on time. Preparation time will be 2mins.

ART & CRAFT ACTIVITIES

1. Slice of Art

Competition- Poster making

Topic/ Theme- Importance of exercise/ India on a path to economic freedom/ Khula asmaan (choose any theme like nature, cityscapes, seascapes, travel diaries)

Instructions and guidelines-

- Duration-1 hour
- Number of participants-1
- Dress Code-School uniform
- The participants are required to make a poster based on the above topic.
- Exceeding the time limit will lead to negative marking.
- The back page should have a message/quote/creative expression in English.
- A3 size sheet will be provided by the school but the participants have to bring their own materials and colours. They can choose any colour of their choice.

2. Trash-terpiece

Competition- Best out of waste competition

Instructions and guidelines-

- Duration-1 hour
- Number of participants-1
- The participants will have to make any utility material from the waste like old can, jar, pencil, box, bangle, plastic wastes etc
- The participants should bring all the required material from their home for the competition.

3. Strokes of Genius

Competition- Sketching Comp

Topic/ Theme- My idol

Instructions and guidelines-

- Duration-1 hour
- Number of participants-1

- The sketch should have a message/quote/creative expression.
- A3 size sheet will be provided by the school but the participants have to bring the required pencils & board on their own.
- The participant should bring the other required materials along with him/her.
